

## Volunteer Overview & Interest Form: **Art Literacy Team Grade Representative**

Thank you for your interest in being a part of the Art Literacy Team. We are fortunate All Saints School supports the arts with extended art education and experience, provided by parent volunteers. It's a great opportunity to be involved in your child's classroom and create some art! The Art Literacy Creative Team sets up two art projects to be completed in the classroom in the fall and spring each year. Prior to going into the classroom there are two Art Literacy Parent Nights where you will learn about the art project and get to do the project yourselves. The Art Literacy Team seeks grade representative volunteers who are excited about this program and have organizational skills to coordinate with grade specific volunteers and teachers to complete the project in the classroom.

### **Liaison Objectives**

- Act as liaison between the teachers/school and parents, coordinating project date/times for fall and spring art literacy projects.
- Communicate with Art Literacy Lead on classroom project dates.
- Generate excitement and promote volunteer opportunities for each classroom project.

### **Term and Responsibilities**

- One-year.
- Reps are selected by the Art Literacy Chair, and principal, based on interest forms submitted.
- Reps may serve more than one year but rotating to a new rep takes priority based on interest from other parents/families.
- Fills 8-10 Fair Share hours obligation, or more if needed.
- All reps are expected to attend two, 1 ½ hr long, Art Literacy Parent Nights, one in the fall and one in the spring, which outline the chosen art literacy project.
- Serve as grade specific contact for parent questions related to Art Literacy.
