**Altar Linen Ministry:** This team maintains clean altar linens for the liturgies. Weekly.

**Altar Serving Ministry:** A perfect opportunity for all young people to take an active role in their faith community by assisting in the Holy Mass.

**Baptism Garments** – This ministry team cuts, sews, and embroiders baby bibs and adult stoles to be worn in the baptism ceremony. As needed.

**Coffee & Doughnuts, Fellowship:** Host coffee, donuts, and juice on Sunday morning after the 8:30 am and 10:30 am Mass services. Monthly.

**Extraordinary Eucharistic Ministry:** To aid the Pastor in the distribution of the Holy Eucharist at weekly Masses. Monthly commitment.

**Facilities:** Help us keep All Saints' campus looking sharp. Think window cleaning, weeding, organizing, sweeping, etc. As needed.

**Flower Team:** The Flower Ministry beautifies our altar and church with flower arrangements and/or plants. Monthly commitment.

**Faith Formation Ministry:** To support all members of the parish in their journey of faith. This includes children's liturgy, Sunday school, youth ministry, RCIA, and prayer group.

**Funeral Reception Ministry:** Help prepare a space for family and friends to share time after a funeral or memorial mass of a loved one. This team welcomes guests and serves a meal provided by the family. Shifts are approximately 2 hours.

**Greeter Ministry:** To serve the parish by offering hospitality to visitors, newcomers, and parishioners at all liturgies and special events. Monthly.

**Lector / Commentator Ministry:** Proclaim the Word of God during the Eucharistic Liturgy and read announcements. Monthly commitment.

**Making Altar Bread:** Learn to make the sacred hosts that are at the heart of our Eucharistic celebration. Monthly for approximately 2 hours.

**Money Counters:** Rotating teams of volunteers assist in counting the weekend collection after the 10:30 am Mass. Monthly commitment.

**Music Ministry:** Share your musical talents by singing or playing an instrument while celebrating the Gospel message of hope, faith, and love for liturgies and special events. Weekly commitment.

**Parish Picnic:** Work alongside fellow parishioners to support the parish picnic. Set-up, clean-up or hosting a station.

**Sacristan Ministry:** This team prepares the altar for mass by lighting candles, arranging the altar, and opening the church before mass begins. Monthly commitment.

**St. Vincent de Paul:** The Saint Vincent de Paul Society was first established at All Saints in 1935. This ongoing food drive provides food distribution to families and individuals in need who are living within the parish boundary. Monthly.

**Wine & Cheese:** Serve wine and cheese to our parishioners after the vigil mass. Meet new friends and share the gift of fellowship with others in our community. Once or twice a year.

**Holiday Bazaar:** Support the parish with this popular fundraising event in November. Be part of set-up, or procurement.
